

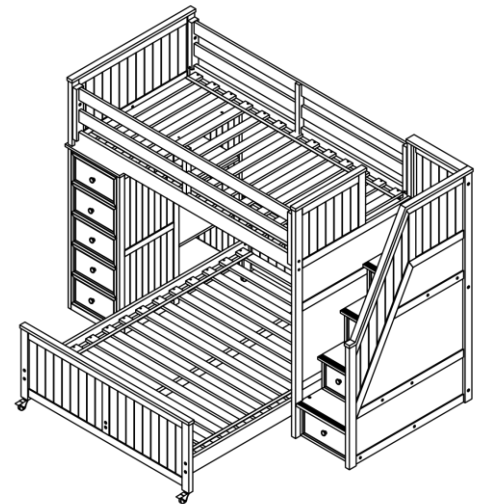
MULTIFUNCTION LOFT BED

Full or Full/Full Assembly Instructions

CONGRATULATIONS,

Thank you for purchasing your Multifunction Loft Bed. Before you begin, we recommend that you thoroughly read these instructions. Do not use power screwdrivers. All of our beds are made from natural woods. Please understand that natural woods have color variations which are the result of nature and not defects in workmanship.

*****Please note these assembly instructions show the assembly for the staircase being assembled on the right side. If you prefer the staircase on the left side, please change the sides in Steps 3 and 4.***



MATTRESS SPECIFICATIONS

The following size mattresses and slat rolls are specified for use with this loft bed.

MATTRESSES:

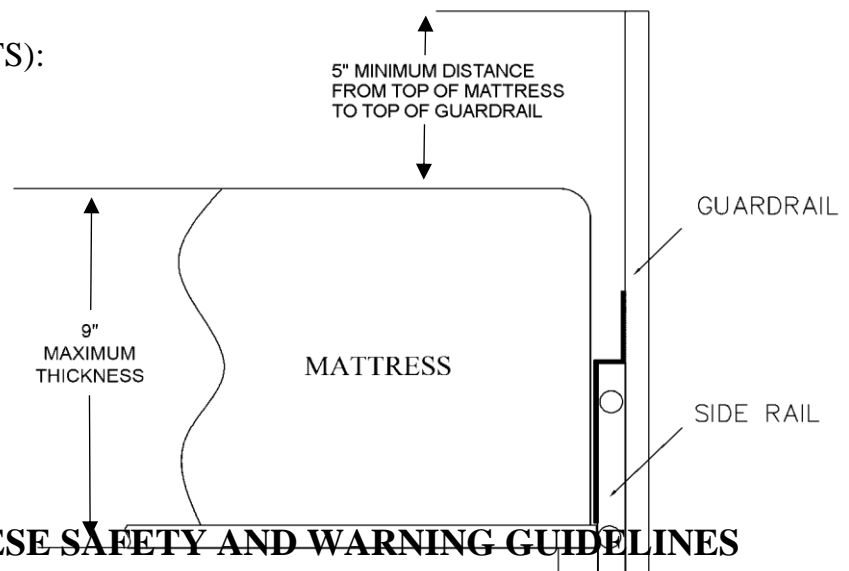
Full - 54" to 55" W 74" to 75" L x 8¼" H max

SLAT ROLL (CONSISTING OF 13 SLATS):

Full - 54 9/16" W X 2½" L x ¾"H

****THESE SPECIFICATIONS MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TOO** in order to avoid the possibility of falling and/or entrapment.



**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE SAFETY AND WARNING GUIDELINES
CAN RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH**

- Do not allow jumping on the bed.

- Always use the recommended size mattress to prevent possible entrapment or falls.
- Do not use wood plugs if you have a child under the age of 6 in the house.
- Periodically check that all screws are tight and secure as they can become loose during normal use of bed. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN!**
- **DO NOT** place loft bed near a window where cords from blinds or curtains may strangle a child.
- **DO NOT** substitute parts. Please contact us immediately for replacement parts or questions.
- Follow the information on the WARNING LABELS appearing on the upper loft bed end structure and on the carton... **DO NOT REMOVE THE WARNING LABEL FROM THE BED!**
- Surface of the mattress must be at least 5 inches (127 mm) below the upper edge of guard rails.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all screws are tight.
- Always use the staircase option for entering and leaving the upper loft bed.
- Use of night light may provide an added safety precaution for a child using the upper loft bed.
- Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper loft bed. If the loft bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrails that run the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses are prohibited.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.
- **STRANGULATION HAZARD** – **NEVER** attach or hang items to any part of the loft bed that are not designed for use with the bed. For example, but not limited to hooks, belts, jump ropes, and etc.

CARE AND CLEANING

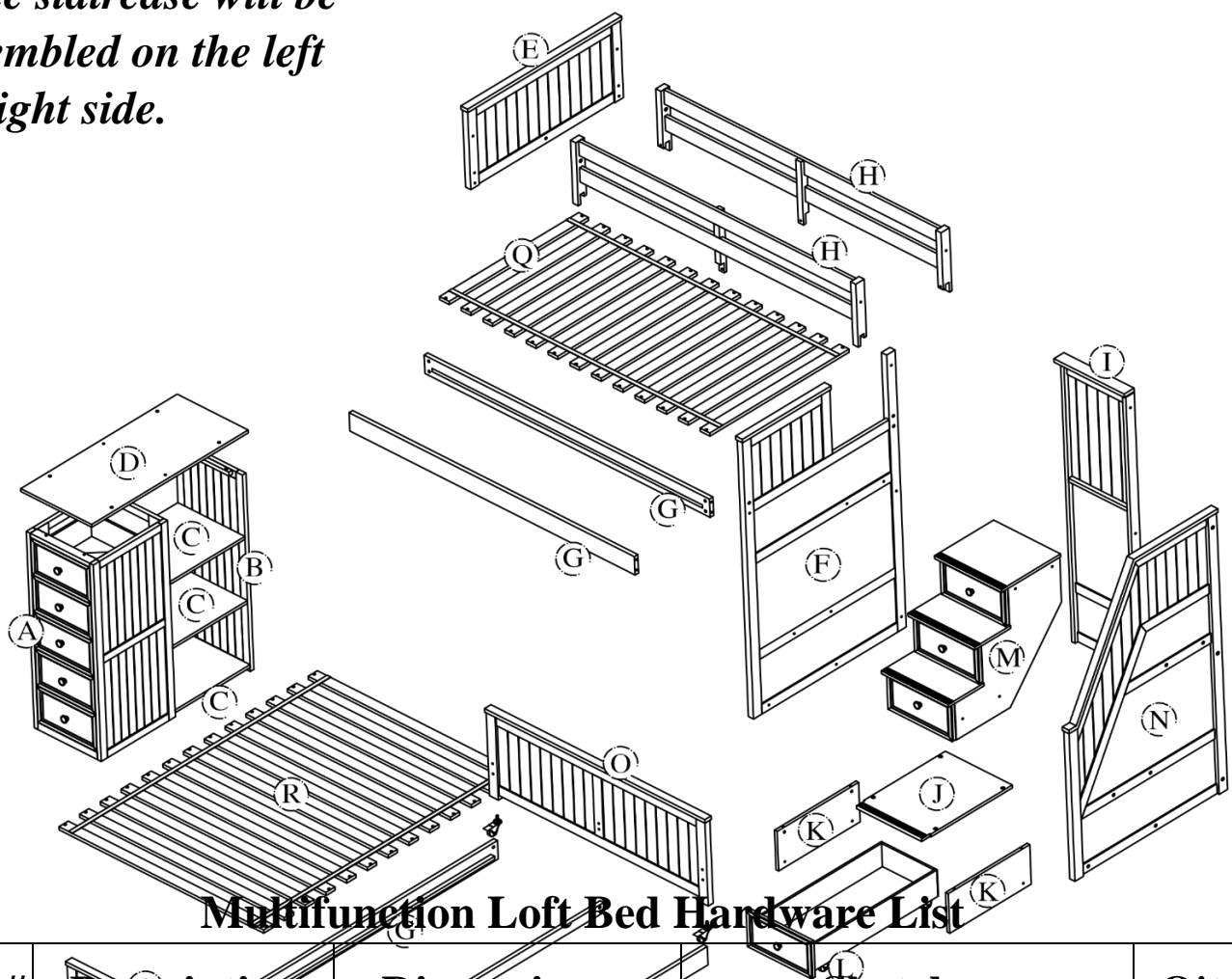
- Do NOT use abrasive chemicals for cleaning. Dust often using a clean, soft, and dry cloth. Rinse and dry cloth thoroughly after use.
- Be careful not to place your furniture in direct sunlight for extended periods of time. As prolonged direct exposure to sunlight can discolor the finish.
- As with all spills, gently blot off spills of any liquids immediately.
- If the loft bed is to be stored; store in a cool, dry place; and carefully package all original hardware to protect from loss.
- If you choose to refinish the furniture; the warranty will be voided.

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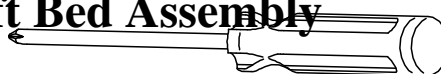

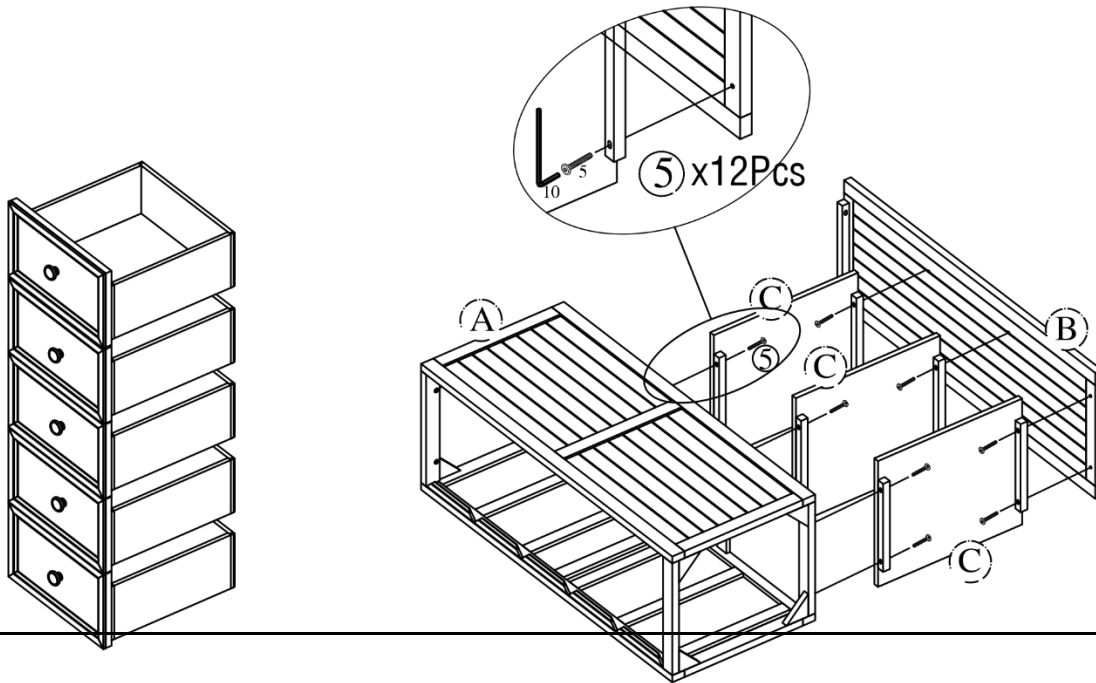

Step 1

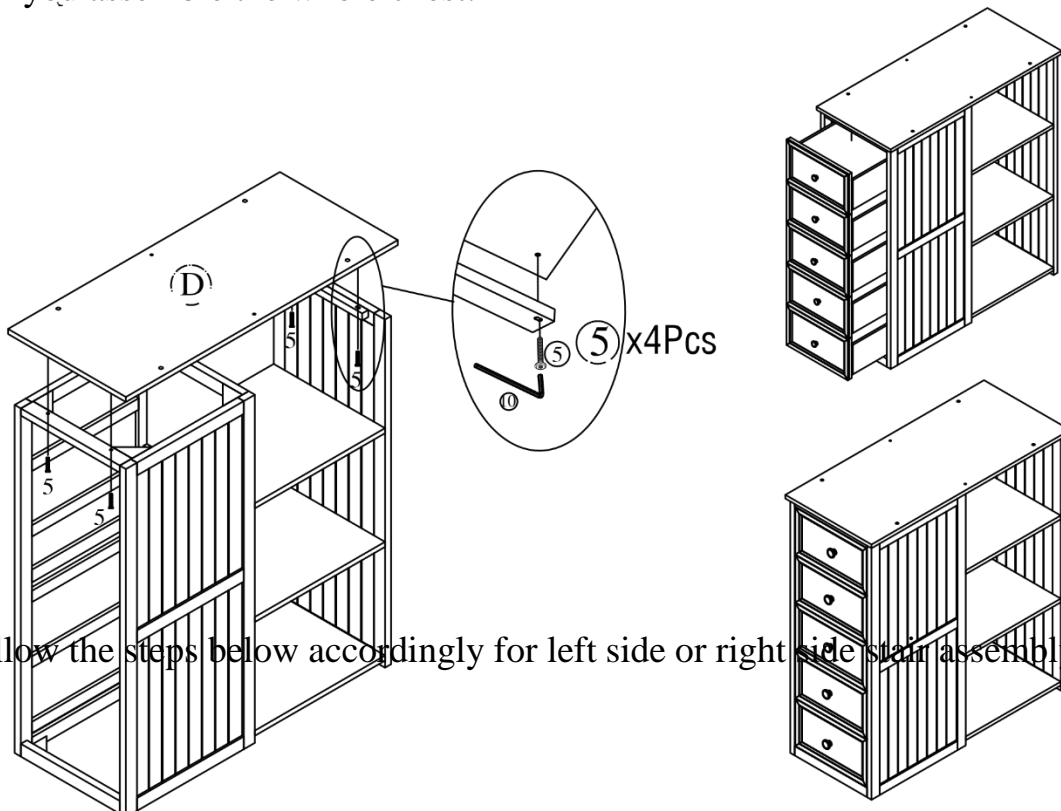


Please take out drawers in order from upper to lower and place them next to you from assembly. Please do not place the drawers in the wrong order. If place in wrong order they will be unstable.

Please place the drawers in the proper order after you assemble the whole chest.

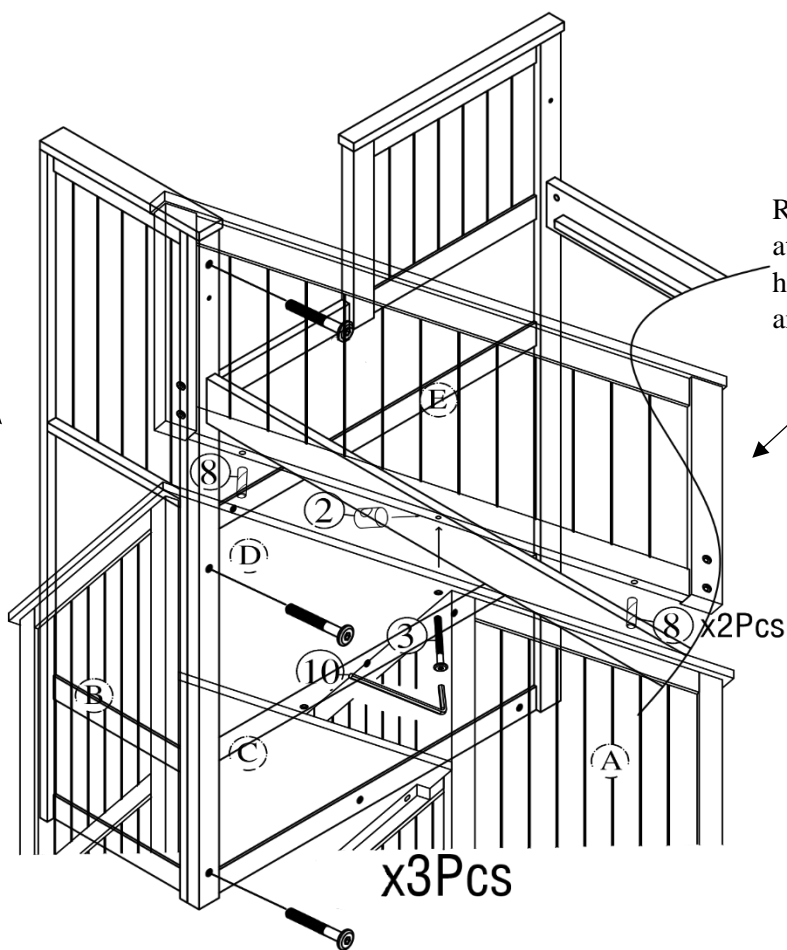


Step 3

Please follow the steps below accordingly for left side or right side stair assembly.

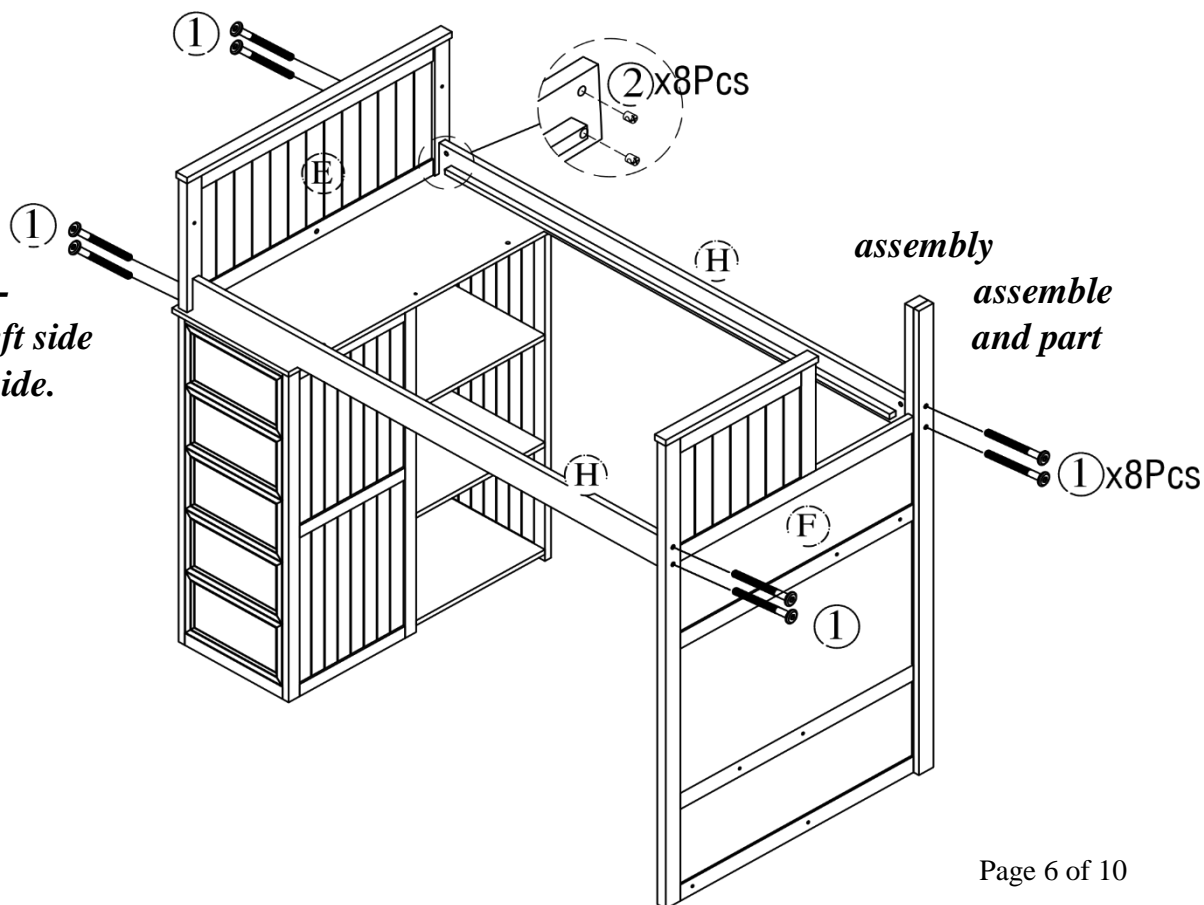
Left side assembly -

and B

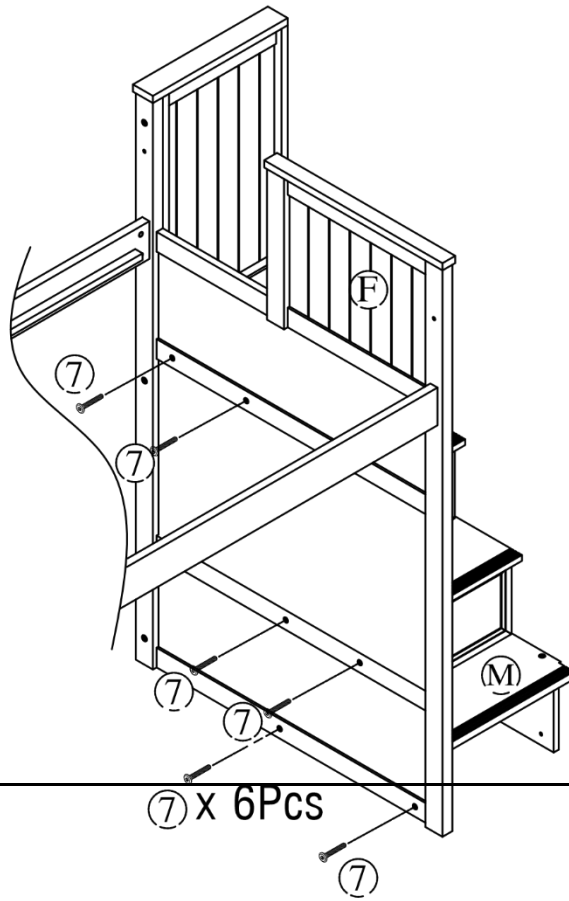
